On 7 March 2014, the Tribute to Women in the Military will mark its 29th anniversary at the Mountain View Club, Kirtland AFB, NM. This is the longest-running event of its kind for military and DoD women at a military installation. The theme for 2014 is “Celebrating Women: Character, Courage, and Commitment”. This non-profit multi-service event honors all military women active, veterans and civilian women affiliated with the Department of Defense. The program presents a keynote speaker, workshops, exhibits, luncheon, awards, and other acknowledgements.

We are seeking donations from businesses for door prizes and small items for our tote bags. We provide between 200-250 tote bags to attendees with the donated items inside. Donors will receive recognition in the event program and publicity before, during, and after the event.
